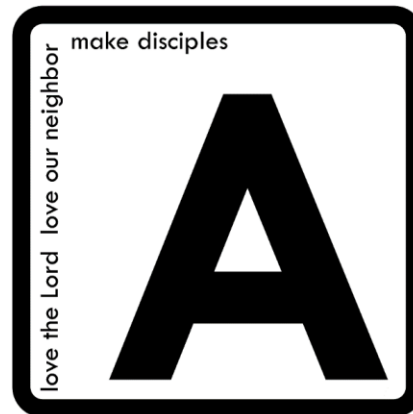
Our **Sunday Service nursery** will remain closed until further notice. Activity bags are available for parents with young children. Please see one of the greeters for more info.
