



PRAYERS for Agape

If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you - John 15:7

Suggested guide for daily prayers:

- 1) Choose 2 passages. Read slowly and consider the text. Look for words or phrases that really stand out.
- 2) Use the passage and suggested prayers as a guide to pray for yourself, for Agape, and for our community.
- 3) Pray the daily focus for the families and teachers from the provided list.
- 4) Consider adding times of worship or fasting to aid you and your family as you pray.

Love the Lord

Sunday's Focus: Wholeheartedness

Psalm 119:10, Isaiah 55:6, Jeremiah 29:13, Revelation 2:2-5, Proverbs 8:17, John 14:21, 1 John 2:5-6, Psalm 86:11, 1 Samuel 12:24, 1 John 5:3, Romans 12:11

Pray that we would call to and seek after God with ALL of our heart, hungry for Him. Repent of any known sin and the times in which we have not loved God with all of our heart. Pray that we would walk with God as our first love, serving him with a passionate spirit.

Monday's Focus: Deliverance

Psalm 32:7, Psalm 119:114, Psalm 9:9, Isaiah 26:3, Isaiah 30:15, 2 Chron 16:9, Psalm 121, Philippians 1:6, Jer 9:23-24

Ask God to hide and deliver Agape from trouble of every kind, whether spiritual or physical. Pray that we would be a people filled with hope, good courage, and perfect peace, because we believe fully that God himself is the shield and keeper of our life. Ask Jesus to give us His strong support, that we might glorify His name with our only boast being that we RELY on Christ for everything!

Tuesday's Focus: Power in the Church

John 4:24, Ephesians 3:16, Jude 1:20-21, Galatians 3:5, Colossians 3:16, Romans 10:17, Romans 10:2

Pray that God would strengthen the people of Agape by His spirit and cause the word of Christ to be ministered to everyone in various ways at each gathering of our people (whether in homes or in the church building). Ask God to help us be people who worship full of the truth of God and full of the Spirit of God, with a zeal that is rooted in knowledge. Pray that God will increase our faith in Him that we might see powerful works of miracles among us that lead us to glorify Him and be thankful.

Love One Another

Wednesday's Focus: Zeal for the Church

Titus 2:14, 2 Thessalonians 3:13, Colossians 3:14, 1 Corinthians 13:4, 1 Corinthians 11:21-22, James 2:8-9, 1 Thessalonians 5:11-15, 2 Corinthians 7:9-11

Pray that Jesus would purify Agape as a people continually zealous for good works toward God and each other. Ask the Lord to give us a love for one another that mirrors the character of His love for us and for a godly grief for our sin that leads to zeal. Pray that we would be a church that shows no partiality but rather are aware of those who feel disconnected and weak, seeking to build them up with encouragement.

Thursday's Focus: Gifts of Grace

1 Corinthians 1:6-7, 1 Pt 4:10, 1 Corinthians 14:1, Philippians 4:19, 2 Corinthians 9:8, Psalm 84:11, 1 Corinthians 9:10-13

Pray that Agape would not lack any spiritual gift that is needed to build us up and to serve one another. Ask the LORD to supply every need we have, blessing us abundantly, that we may abound in every good work and see his purposes for us fulfilled. Pray that we would be people of sacrificial generosity, who love to give and serve that we might glorify God and exhort one another in the faith.

Make Disciples

Friday's Focus: Effective Evangelism

Acts 2:46-47, Colossians 4:5-6, 2 Thessalonians 3:1-3, 1 Corinthians 14:23-25, Acts 4:29-31, Acts 11:21, 2 Corinthians 5:20

Pray for God to fill the people of Agape with the Holy Spirit to speak His word boldly and with graciousness, knowing how to answer each person who has questions about the faith. Ask that He would give us favor with the people of Pinson and the surrounding areas and that a great number of them would be saved, baptized, and discipled among us. Pray that we would be good ambassadors for Christ, with a good reputation and that the Gospel would advance because of His presence among us.

Saturday's Focus: To Become a LightHouse

Philippians 2:15, Isaiah 60:1-3, Matthew 5:14-16, James 1:27

Pray for Agape to be a lighthouse to our community, shining brightly as people set apart, gracious, and dedicated to Jesus alone. Ask the Lord to give us good works to do in His name and to cause people to come to his light at Agape. Pray for a new ministry we are starting – called Lighthouse - dedicated to strengthening marriages, families, and supporting adoption and foster care. Ask God to please empower this ministry and let it bear much fruit in the days and years ahead.
