Join us at Agape for Worship

Each daily scripture and prayer focus are related to one of the **7 themes** we are praying through as a church in 2022:

- 1) **Worship** May God help Agape to grow together in knowledge and affection for Him, as our supreme love.
- 2) Harmony May God help Agape to have mutual encouragement, oneness, forgiveness, and love among our people.
- 3) **Prayer** May God help Agape to become a House of Prayer, that embraces the necessity of prayer and finds delight in praying.
- 4) Wisdom May God help Agape to be a wise church, always advancing in godly living and character.
- 5) Spirit May God help Agape to walk in Spiritual gifts and the present help of the Holy Spirit His power and freedom.
- 6) Fruitful May God help Agape to always abide in Christ, bearing fruitfulness in all good works and discipleship.
- 7) Witness May God help Agape to be a lighthouse, shining the light of Christ and seeing many saved and added to His household.

Use this guide as a starting point for daily prayers:

- **Sept 5:** Loving Father, please take captive our hearts to the love You have so abundantly poured out upon us as Your children. May our affection for You overflow into our daily life. May our faith ever increase in the confidence of Your love for us through the steadfastness of Christ. Keep our feet from stumbling and our hearts from straying with the constant encouragement of the love You have for us.
- Sept 6: Pray that Agape will be a church focused on the Gospel. Pray for unity, sincere corporate worship, & fellowship.
- **Sept 7**: Pray the Lord will give us Gospel opportunities in our everyday routines. Ask that we will be ready with testimonies of God's goodness and faithfulness to share with those who need to know Him.
- **Sept 8:** Pray the Holy Spirit will be present and active in our daily lives. Ask that He will empower and rejuvenate our faith so that we may live in a way that pleases and honors the Lord.
- **Sept 9:** Gracious Father, thank You for Your sanctifying work in us. Please continue to draw our hearts to walk in a manner worthy of Your calling on our lives. May the sin that so easily entangles us fall to the ground through the precious blood of Jesus and give us resolve to walk and work according to the power of Your Spirit that now lives in us. May Jesus be glorified in us as we are glorified in Him.
- Sept 10: Pray that we will know the Word of God; that we will desire, absorb, understand, and share the Word.
- **Sept 12:** Pray that I will grow in a desire for and practice of fervent prayer in my life; that I will pray for those in my life and at large in the word around me. Ask that through prayer, I will have a personal connection and abiding with the Lord.
- **Sept 13:** Righteous Father, thank You so much for sending Jesus to make known to us Your salvation and deliverance. Thank you for not just showing us the power of Your love, but imparting it to us. Transform us by this truth today that we may be drawn ever closer to You and shine brighter each day the glory of Jesus, our Lord.
- **Sept 15:** Holy Father, help us to truly abound in love toward our brothers and sisters in Christ. Please establish our hearts to walk steadfastly in Your love and in holiness before You. May we not be ashamed at Your coming, but be found ready, full of grace, truth, and love for each other and for You!
- **Sept 16**: Pray that Agape will follow the model of John who bore witness to the light, making less of himself so he could make more of Jesus. Pray that we will be unashamed to share the truth of the gospel with those who do not know Him.
- **Sept 17:** Pray that Agape will be a church where people can come to be encouraged in the Lord and to become an encourager to others. May we live so committed to the Gospel and serving with our spiritual gifts that our faith will spur one another into deeper relationship with Christ.
- **Sept 19:** Ever Powerful Father, keep our hearts and minds stayed upon Jesus, the true Vine. May we live every moment bearing kingdom fruit for the glory of Your great Name! Please empower us with your Holy Spirit today so that everything we think, say, and do will be the result of abiding in You. May the lost see the fruit we bear and be challenged, convicted, and encouraged to know Jesus, our Redeemer, Deliver, Savior and King.
- **Sept 20**: Ask the Father to help us be a people that responds to every impulse to pray; casting every concern of our hearts upon Him. Pray that we would be a church filled with His gifts for prayer, including prophecy as He sees fit.
- **Sept 21:** Pray that our first thoughts, priorities, and concerns will be on the Lord and how He would have us to live. Ask that He would enable us to trust Him with every area of our life.
- **Sept 22:** Ever Present Father, help us to walk in the unity of the faith. Just as You and Jesus are one, make us one in Your Spirit that we may we know the glory that has been given to us through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Let us realize the blessing that comes from the oneness of unity that You alone can give and may the world see and know that You are God as we display the power of Your love through that unity.
- **Sept 23:** Pray God's work of sanctification awareness of & freedom from sin will continue in our lives. Pray that we will grow in our relationships in the Body of Christ for the sake of wisdom and the good of one another's sanctification as well.
