A Reading From

Hebrews 9 (CSB)

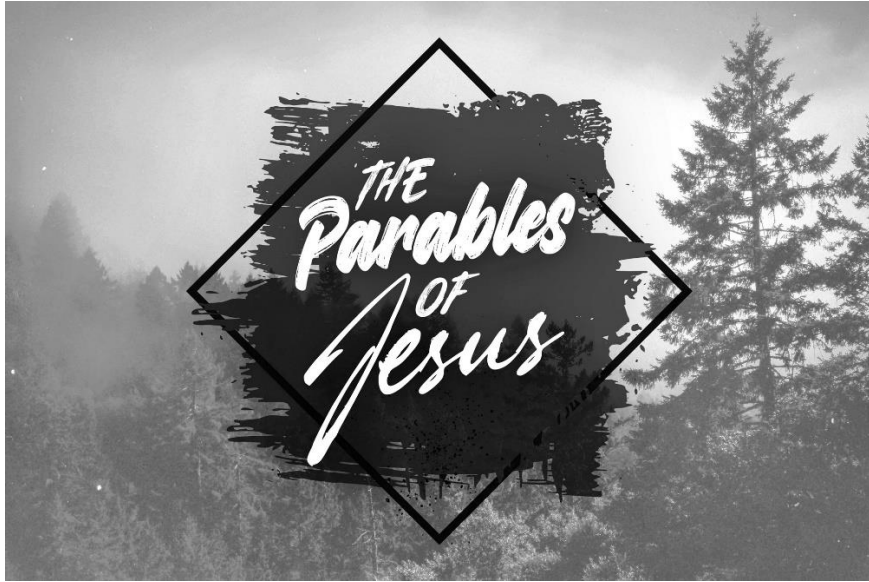
The first covenant also had regulations for ministry and an earthly sanctuary. For a tabernacle was set up behind the second curtain was a tent called the most holy place. It had the gold altar of incense and the ark of the covenant... With these things prepared like this, the priests enter the first room repeatedly, performing their ministry. The high priest alone enters the second room, and he does that only once a year, never without blood, which he offers for himself and for the sins the people had committed in ignorance. *The Holy Spirit was making it clear that the way into the most holy place had not yet been disclosed...* This is a symbol for the present time, during which **gifts and sacrifices are offered that cannot perfect the worshiper's conscience**. But *Christ has appeared as a high priest of the good things that have come*. In the greater, more perfect tabernacle not made with hands... he entered the most holy place once for all time, not by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls... sprinkling those who are defiled, sanctify for the purification of the flesh, *how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works so that we can serve the living God?*

Luke 7 (CSB)



⁴⁰ Jesus replied to him, “Simon, I have something to say to you.” He said, “Say it, teacher.” ⁴¹ “A creditor had two debtors. One owed 500 denarii, and the other 50. ⁴² Since they could not pay it back, he graciously forgave them both. So, which of them will love him more?” ⁴³ Simon answered, “I suppose the one he forgave more.” “You have judged correctly,” he told him.

⁴⁴ Turning to the woman, he said to Simon, “Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave me no water for my feet, but she, with her tears, has washed my feet and wiped them with her hair. ⁴⁵ You gave me no kiss, but she hasn’t stopped kissing my feet since I came in. ⁴⁶ You didn’t anoint my head with olive oil, but she has anointed my feet with perfume. ⁴⁷ Therefore I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven; that’s why she loved much. But the one who is forgiven little, loves little.”
