### Today's Text

Psalm 19 (CSB)

*For the choir director. A psalm of David.* <sup>1</sup>The heavens declare the glory of God, and the expanse proclaims the work of his hands. <sup>2</sup>Day after day they pour out speech; night after night they communicate knowledge. <sup>3</sup>There is no speech; there are no words; their voice is not heard. <sup>4</sup>Their message has gone out to the whole earth, and their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens he has pitched a tent for the sun. <sup>5</sup>It is like a bridegroom coming from his home; it rejoices like an athlete running a course. <sup>6</sup>It rises from one end of the heavens and circles to their other end; nothing is hidden from its heat.

<sup>7</sup>The instruction of the Lord is perfect, renewing one's life; the testimony of the Lord is trustworthy, making the inexperienced wise. <sup>8</sup>The precepts of the Lord are right, making the heart glad; the command of the Lord is radiant, making the eyes light up. <sup>9</sup>The fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever; the ordinances of the Lord are reliable and altogether righteous.

Cleanse me from my hidden faults. <sup>13</sup>Moreover, keep your servant from willful sins; do not let them rule me. Then I will be blameless and cleansed from blatant rebellion. <sup>14</sup>May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable to you, Lord, my rock and my Redeemer.
