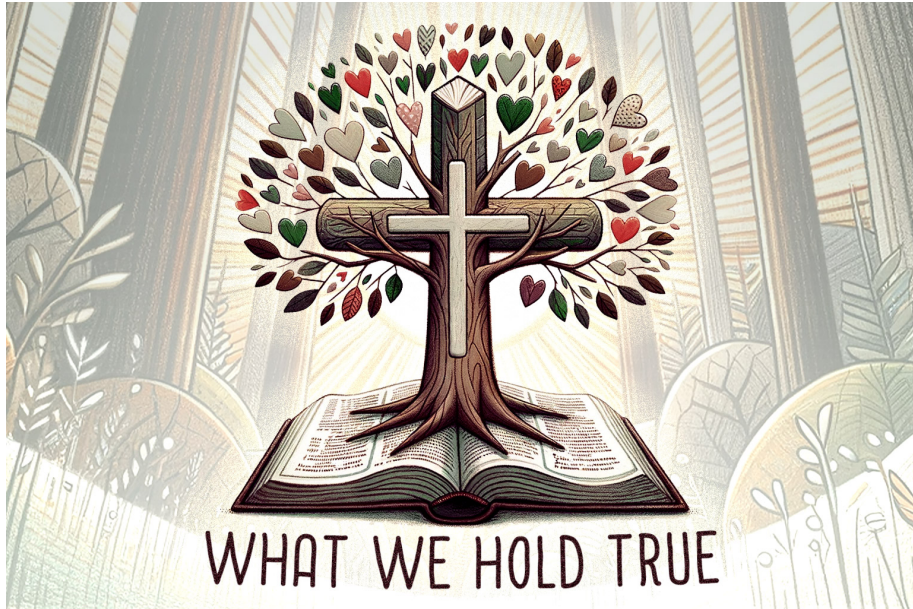

Salvation in Christ

Core Beliefs

At Agape Church, we believe that salvation into Christ occurs by grace through faith. Scripture teaches that one who desires to be saved must sincerely believe from their heart that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, raised from the dead after suffering for the redemption of sins, and that this belief leads them to repentance of sin and confession that Jesus is LORD. Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD in this way will be saved – not by their own works but by belief in the finished work of Jesus on their behalf.
